

**Query and Clarification for printing and supply of CLF Books of Records under BTDP held on 18-06-2018 at 03:00 PM at BRLPS Office, Patna.**

Query	Clarification
Is it necessary to submit original affidavit regarding correctness of information furnished with bid document. Refer point no 7 of Invitation for bids (IFB).	It is clarified that it is necessary to submit original affidavit regarding correctness of information furnished with bid document after opening of bid. The same should be submitted in hard copy within five days from the date of opening, failing which the bids will be declared non responsive and will not be considered for evaluation.
Is sample of paper will be submitted in office?	No, sample of paper will not be submitted at this stage. Only successful bidder has to submit one set of CLF Books of Records as a sample as per required specification, which will be verified for quality.
Is each page of bid documents will be signed and stamped?	It is clarified that each page of bidding document along with supporting document should be signed and stamped and same will be uploaded on eproc.bihar.gov.in.
<p>As per SI no 17 of technical Specification, the specification of Hard Bound Carry Case for CLF Books is :-            Size - 43cmX32cm.            Specification- Hard Board ( 32 Ounce) Box with Printing. Three side mechanically packed and one side open without using adhesive. Plastic handle for carrying. Details of inside material printed on cover. Width, Height and length should be such that all 15 materials would be kept inside box and could be carried away.            *Specification may be further updated after consulting experts/printers.</p> <p>Is it final specification?</p>	<p>Revised specification of bound carry case (Box) for CLF Books of records are as follows:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5 ply corrugated box (Cartoon).</li> <li>• Dimension – 48 cm X 38 cm X 35 cm.</li> <li>• Box has to be strapped (minimum 2 plastic strips).</li> <li>• Name of the items to be supplied will be printed (one side) on box.</li> <li>• All types of items in one set (i.e 16 items) must be packed in each box.</li> </ul>
The companies registered with MSME and NSIC do not require to submit the EMD as per government rules as they are exempted being registered with MSME and NSIC.	As per World Bank Guidelines, there is no exemption from submitting Bid Security/ EMD.
