**Alcohol Prohibition Programme, Patna Division, JEEVIKA**  
**14<sup>th</sup> June 2016**

**The Programme**

Honourable Chief Minister of Bihar, Sri Nitish Kumar addressed around 3000 Jeevika SHG members gathered to participate in the Alcohol prohibition programme organised by Jeevika Patna division on 11<sup>th</sup> May 2016 in S. K. Memorial Hall Patna. The SHG members from various blocks of all the districts of Patna division – Patna, Nalanda, Buxur, Bhojpur and Rohtas came to participate in the programme. Sri Nitish Kumar inaugurated the programme by lighting the inaugural lamp.



Before coming to the stage honourable chief minister and all the dignitaries visited the Jeevika stalls related to various themes and interventions of Jeevika. On the stage, the community members welcomed all the dignitaries by presenting them flower bouquet. The programme formally started with welcome address by Sri Arvind Kumar Choudhary, Secretary, RDD, GOB. Jeevika SHG members of Patna division shared their experiences about alcohol prohibition campaign. They talked about their misery at the hands of liquor and how they fought with the evil of liquor in their respective villages.

The chief minister handed over a cheque of Rs. 1 lakh each to some of the Jeevika Village Organisations that have fought against the evil of liquor have made their villages alcohol free. The Kala Jattha of Patna district presented some songs on alcohol prohibition in the programme. Honourable deputy chief minister of Bihar, Sri Tejaswi Yadav addressed the Community members and appreciated them for their effort towards alcohol prohibition in their villages. बिहार में शराबबंदी की बुनियाद रखने और इस अभियान में बढ़चढ़ कर हिस्सा लेने वाली स्वयं सहायता समूह (एसएचजी) की महिलाओं को राज्य सरकार जल्द ही बड़ी जिम्मेदारी सौंपेगी। मुख्यमंत्री नीतीश कुमार ने घोषणा की कि स्वयं सहायता समूह की महिलाएं हर माह विद्यालयों की जांच करेंगी। वे देखेंगी कि मास्टर साहब विद्यालय आते हैं कि गायब रहते हैं। विद्यालय में हैं तो पढ़ा रहे हैं या नहीं। बच्चे रोज आते हैं या नहीं। स्कूलों में साफ-सफाई की स्थिति क्या है। पीने का पानी, मिड डे मील और शौचालय की व्यवस्था है या नहीं, यह सब देखेंगी महिलाएं। महीने में कम-से-कम एक बार स्कूल का औचक निरीक्षण करेंगी और राज्य सरकार को जांच रिपोर्ट देंगी। उनकी रिपोर्ट के आधार पर सरकार संबंधित शिक्षकों-कर्मियों पर कार्रवाई करेगी।

मुख्यमंत्री मंगलवार को श्री कृष्ण मेमोरियल हॉल में पटना प्रमंडल की जीविका समूह की दीदियों की सभा को संबोधित कर रहे थे। उन्होंने कहा कि 99 फीसदी बच्चों के नाम विद्यालयों में दर्ज हैं, लेकिन 50-60 फीसदी ही रोज
